Awards: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class, provided that they have earned qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score. Rosettes will also be awarded for new titles, MACH titles, and PAX titles. Jump bars will be awarded to those completing MACH and PAX titles.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Height Divisions: Owners/agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs in the Preferred classes MUST jump in their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores and placements earned will be disallowed. Therefore, if you are unsure of your dog's correct jump height, please enter the lower height and if necessary your dog will be moved to the higher height.

Notice to Exhibitors

- *Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial each exhibitor acknowledges that they are familiar with the current AKC Agility Rules and Regulations and that their dog is familiar with and is able to perform all obstacles safely.*
- Please include a copy of the dog's AKC height card with this entry. Dogs without height cards must be measured by a judge prior to check-in and competing.
- *Dogs that don't need to be measured are not required to be at the show site until check-in prior to the start of their class.*
- **Pre-Trial Move-up forms must be received by 6 p.m. (Eastern Time) June 15, 2010**
- **Move-ups during the trial will be allowed. Forms for next day move-up must be received by the Trial Secretary before the trial finishes for the day.**
- Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and do not constitute a valid entry (AKC Rules, CH 14, Sec 4). Please type or print and check over the entry form before mailing.
- Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks.
- FAX, telephone, unsigned entries, or those without correct fees cannot be accepted.
- **Entries not on an official AKC entry form (or copy) including the waiver agreement are not acceptable and NO MORE THAN 10 ENTRIES MAY BE SENT IN ONE ENVELOPE!!!**
- No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US FUNDS.
- Kalamazoo Kennel Club assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- All Express deliveries MUST include signature waiver or will not be received. Please note, express delivery of entries has never been required in the past.
- Entries will only be accepted sent to the Secretary's address.
- Entries will be acknowledged after closing and will include a judging program.
- Kalamazoo Kennel Club may decline any entries or may remove any dog due to disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against Kalamazoo Kennel Club or any official thereof.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry will be refunded in event of errors, or cancellation of such entry after the closing date. Please read the confirmation letter and correct any errors at that time. **NO CORRECTIONS WILL BE MADE AT THE TRIALS.**
- ENTRY fees shall not be refunded: in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Agility Trial Committee. Or because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Agility Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed on the grounds or to compete in the trial. Refunds of 80% of the entry fee will be allowed for bitches in season if the request is received prior to the opening of the trial and accompanied by a veterinarian's statement.
- Exhibitors must wear their "armband" number when exhibiting their dog.
- Kalamazoo Kennel Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show.
- Puppies under the age of 6 months are not allowed on the show site.
- Crates inside the building must have a floor covering underneath to protect the mats.
- All dogs must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the warm-up area. Remember dogs must enter and leave the ring under control.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.
- **Please clean up after your dog.** Receptacles will be provided.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
