JUNIOR ENTRY FEES: \$15 per entry. Juniors must include their AKC Junior number to use discounted price.

Entries Close: Wednesday, July 10, 2024, or whenever limits have been met. Express deliveries must include signature waiver.

Mail entries to: KKC Trial Sec. Laura Endres, 9177 West G Avenue, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49009 Bitches in season will not be allowed on the grounds or to compete in the trial. A refund of all but \$5.00 of each entry fee per event will be made to an exhibitor with a bitch that has come into season after the close of entries.

Crating Space is limited and in designated areas only. Exhibitors may be asked to stack crates.

Notice to exhibitors

Faxed, telephoned or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and Photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as possible after the closing date with the judging program and directions to the show site. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Overnight or express entries MUST have waiver of signature. Failure to do so may result in your entry not being picked up in a timely manner.

AKC Event & Recording Fees will be required for the first entry of each dog entered in any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. The fees are to be collected by the trial giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the entire first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The recording and event fees are included in the entry fee.

No Entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entries will be made.

Post Dated and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The trial giving Club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of the returned check.
