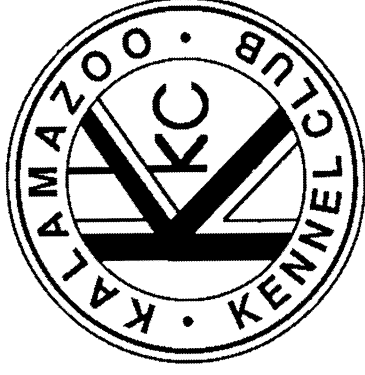

Directions To Kalamazoo Kennel Club

From the North or South:

US Hwy 131, Exit #44, East on D Ave to building on right, just past Douglas Street.

From the East or West:

I-94 to US Hwy 131 North to Exit #44, turn right (East) on D Ave to Building on right, just past Douglas Street.
The Kennel Club is the large white building on the right.
If you go over the Kalamazoo River you have gone too far.

Ribbons and Rosettes

A light blue flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog achieving a qualifying run.
Rosettes will be awarded to each dog completing a title.



EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Show Hours each day 8am until all runs are completed or 3pm.

- **ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per test for early registration.**
DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: If numerical limit (125 entries per test) is Not reached Day of Show entries will be accepted from 1-2pm and run in Block 4: 2-3pm. **The entry fee for DOS is \$30.00 per test.**
- Entries not on an official AKC entry form (or official copy), including the waiver agreement, are not acceptable.
- **Owners** are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms. Incomplete, illegible, or entries without correct fees cannot be accepted. No entry will be refunded in event of errors. No entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Post-dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee; There will be \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- **No telephone or FAX entries.**
- **Canadian** exhibitors must make fees payable in **US FUNDS.**
- **All Express deliveries MUST** include signature waiver or may not be received.
- Entries will only be accepted mailed to the Test Secretary's address.
- Entries will be acknowledged after closing.
- **Kalamazoo Kennel Club assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.**
- **ENTRY fees shall not be refunded** because of riots, civil disturbances, severe weather, or other acts beyond the control of the Test Committee that make it impossible to open or complete the trial. In the event a dog is excused by a veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee a refund of all but \$5.00 of each entry fee per event will be made to the exhibitor. Bitches in season will not be allowed on the grounds or to compete in the trial. A refund of all but \$5.00 of each entry fee per event will be made to an exhibitor with a bitch that has come into season after the close of entries.
- **Dog show hours are 8am to 3pm.**
- **Dogs must be on a short leash and under control.**
- **KKC reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.**
- **The field is artificial turf with a 125-foot sand runoff; it is fully, & double fenced.**
- **The lure is a continuous loop.**
- **All dogs require a releaser AND a catcher and TWO leashes.**
- **KKC does not provide volunteers for catching & releasing.**
- **Indoor crating with heat/AC is available; warming/cooling areas will be provided.**
- **Potty your dogs BEFORE entering the course!**
- **Kalamazoo Kennel Club may decline any entry or may remove any dog due to disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against Kalamazoo Kennel Club, or any official thereof.**
- **Tests will run concurrently; Volunteer's dogs will run first.**
- **All dogs must be inspected prior to each run. All dogs must be checked-in prior to 10:00am for morning runs and prior to 1:00pm for afternoon runs.**
- **Inspection begins at 8am for am blocks and at 12pm for all afternoon blocks.**

- These events will be run with an established run order to the best ability of the Paddock Master. Dogs will run in order **only if** they are checked in, in line, and ready with both a releaser **AND** a catcher. Your timeliness helps the event run smoothly for everyone!
- Adjustments due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances may be necessary.
- There will be a 60 minute lunch break immediately following the morning runs.

AGREEMENT I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC; the event-giving club; their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretaries; the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event; and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties; and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises; or grounds or near any entrance thereto; and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.
